

Monetary Support Application Process for Competitive Teams representing the North Bay Granite Club

The North Bay Granite Club will consider supporting competitive teams in one of the three ways:

- Level 1 Monetary sponsorship for Teams qualifying at a Provincial level or higher and/or qualifying for Winter Games. Dollar amount is subject to change based on travel requirements, as well as the length and location of the event.
- Level 2 Hosting a send off party for Teams heading to compete at a National level. Teams will take the lead in organizing the event and be present. Teams will have access to use the facility at no rental cost and will have opportunity to raise funds through self-run initiatives.
- Pro Shop Discount For Teams registered to compete at the Provincial and/or National level. Up to 20% on equipment to be used in competition.

Teams are asked to submit an application to the Board of Directors bod@northbaygraniteclub.com, ensuring that the application includes the required information listed below. Each application will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. The decision to support, and the level of support being offered will be communicated to the individual listed as the Team Contact.

Information to be included in the Team Application:

- 1. Team Name & Team Contact Person (please include email address and phone number for the contact person).
- 2. Team Bio (please include the names of all members of the team, and a summary of their individual accomplishments to date).
- 3. Team Accomplishments.
- 4. Events the Team has competed in and/or plans to compete in for the upcoming curling season.
- 5. Team Goals for the upcoming season.
- 6. Sponsorship received to date.
- 7. Expected expenses for the upcoming curling season.
- 8. If granted sponsorship from the North Bay Granite club, how the team plans to recognize this sponsorship.

**NOTE:** The Board of Directors of the North Bay Granite Club has the final decision regarding support to competitive teams, and this will be based on the current financials of the Club.
